Youth Class Tuition:

Payment of \$195 is due on the first day of class for every 5 continuous classes. Payment is made by cash or check, made payable to Zoll Studio. Materials are covered in the tuition. Checks are cashed at the end of each month.

Absences:

There are **no make-up classes**. When a seat in the classroom is reserved for 5 consecutive classes, that seat **cannot** be offered to another student. If there is an emergency or health issue, and you notify the instructor prior to that absence, the instructor may offer a courtesy make-up if they have space. This courtesy is only offered once each trimester, for any reason. If a family discovers that they need to take off between payment cycles, the studio understands, but a seat **will not** be held.

Trimesters:

September- end of December

January- through end of May

June- August (treated differently due to summer vacations)

Refunds:

After a payment is received at the beginning of the 5 classes, no refund is offered. The student is expected to attend for the 5 consecutive reserved classes.

Illnesses:

Students need to be **fever free and symptom free for 24 hours**. When in doubt, please wear a mask.

Class Size:

Youth classes are intentionally kept small to maintain a low student/ instructor ratio. This policy provides students with art instruction that is more tailored to their age, individual ability and interest. Some classes hire an assistant to help maintain a low student/ instructor ratio.

Continuous Classes:

It is expected that when a student enrolls, that student will continue throughout the year, sending in a payment after each 5th class is completed. Please contact instructor if your schedule changes.

Weather Policy:

Zoll Studio loosely follows BCPS (Baltimore County Public Schools) winter weather related closings. If BCPS is closed then Zoll Studio will be closed. If BCPS opens late then Zoll Studio will open on time. If BCPS closes early then the studio will close early. **EXCEPTION:** Please watch for an email, text or phone call if the weather doesn't seem to be really bad. Sometimes the individual instructor will determine the status of a later afternoon or evening class.

Handicap Access:

The back entrance to the studio is handicap accessible. If the door is locked, call the studio and someone will open the door. 410-296-0233.

Photos:

From time to time, photographs of artwork or groups of students working on art projects are taken as a way to advertise or promote the studio. Any students in a photo are not identified. No compensation is provided to individuals that happen to be in that photograph.

Property and Dismissal:

Zoll Studio, LLC. and it's instructors do not accept responsibility for loss, damage, or the theft of any student's property. During dismissal, students may not leave the building until there is parent supervision. If a parent knows they will be late, please inform the child or instructor because Zoll Studio usually closes 5-10 minutes after class ends.

Annual Zoll Studio Art Show and Exhibit:

All students are encouraged to display some of their better artwork in the Zoll Studio art show, held each year during the weekend prior to Thanksgiving. It is a large art show of youth, adult and instructor work with over 600 guest attending during the weekend event. An email will go out to parents about 6 weeks before the show, requesting that artwork be readied and dropped off for the studio for hanging. The students truly enjoy seeing their artwork displayed in an official art show, so please add this event to your calendar. This year's show will be November 17, 18, 19, 2023.
